

Award of the honorary medal of the Juliusz Paweł Schauder Center for Nonlinear Studies

Rules And Qualifications For Awarding

1. The organizer of the competition for the Juliusz Paweł Schauder Medal, hereinafter referred to as the "Medal," is the Scientific Council of the Juliusz Paweł Schauder University Center for Nonlinear Studies at Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń, hereinafter referred to as the "Center Council."
2. The Medal is an individual award granted for achievements in the field of nonlinear analysis.
3. The awarding of the Medal, whose pattern is attached to Ordinance No. 76 of the UMK Rector dated April 24, 2020, takes place no more often than every two years.
4. The basis for awarding the Medal is a scientific achievement documented in published original scientific works or monographs related to the competition's topic.
5. Candidates for the competition may be nominated by members of the Center Council or other persons with established scientific authority.
6. Applications for the Medal may be submitted to the Center until the end of December of the year preceding the year of the competition results announcement.
7. The application, along with justification, should be sent to the Juliusz Paweł Schauder University Center for Nonlinear Studies, ul. Chopina 12/18, 87-100 Toruń, or electronically to cbn@umk.pl.
8. The laureate is selected by a jury appointed by the Center Council.
9. The results of the competition are announced by the end of May of the year preceding the planned Medal presentation.
10. The jury's decision is final and not subject to appeal.
11. The competition laureate receives:
 - a) The Medal along with a diploma,
 - b) An invitation, at the expense of the Juliusz Paweł Schauder University Center for Nonlinear Studies, to participate in the Medal awarding ceremony and the accompanying scientific event, as well as to deliver a plenary lecture related to the achievements for which the Medal was awarded.
12. The Medal and diploma will be presented during a ceremony organized in consultation with the UMK Rector.
13. The organizational support for the competition is provided by the Center.
14. The Center maintains a register of awarded Medals along with complete competition documentation.
